Water Quality – What you need to know Year 2

Based on last year's successful treatment program, the LSIA will complete another "whole lake" Curly Leaf Pondweed (CLP) treatment in 2014!

We are asking for a tax-deductable donation of \$100 per lot.

Block Captains will be contacting you in the next few weeks to collect donations, help raise awareness, collect needed signatures, post application notice signs, and promote LSIA membership/donations.

Working together as an association on a "whole lake" approach is clearly a more cost effective approach – and is the only long-term solution to controlling CLP, our worst invasive plant species.

Volunteer applied treatment. By self-treating we control timing of the early season, low dose treatment, which helps ensure the most ideal conditions and effectiveness (and we save 50% of the cost vs. hiring a professional treatment company).

It's a Bird, It's a Plane – Ron Jorgenson's New Toy

Ron & Mary Jorgenson decided to sell their Arizona home and stay here in Minnesota for the



winter. Needing a project, Ron added tracks to his Kubota 4x4 and outfitted it with a commercial trail groomer that he purchased down south somewhere. Ron groomed the trail at least twice a week and currently has it set to imprint a single pair of cross country ski grooves in the middle of the groomed trail. By varying the angle and the amount of snow carried on the groomer he can regulate the depth of the trail as he goes. The trail is 6-8 miles in length and runs close to the shoreline except where it goes out to avoid the lake neighbors skating rinks. Hopefully you were able to try it out!

The Jorgenson's have always been generous,

caring and involved lake neighbors. From hosting the annual LSIA Picnic and National Night Out parties on their property, removing and moving wayward bogs, donating to lake improvement projects, and serving on the Association Board.
