Water Quality Update

I would like to start out by thanking everyone who donated toward our Curly Leaf Pondweed (CLP) and Eurasian Water Milfoil (EWM) treatments. We collected over \$33,000 for our treatments. A special thank you goes to Ron Jorgenson who personally donated \$5,000. Thank you Ron and everyone who helped make our treatments possible.

The suggested \$250 donation this year was a sharp increase from years past, however when we compare our whole lake treatment to what it would cost each individual homeowner, we're saving money and treating more lakeshore by doing it together. We're happy to announce our post inspection for CLP produced no live plants meaning our treatment was a success. During this inspection we identified where EWM was present and during the last week of June we treated just over 30 acres of the lake for EWM.

Next year will be year five of our five-year plan. We won't know until next season's pre-inspection if it will be a whole lake treatment again, however, funding from the DNR will still be limited. Over the next couple months, we'll reassess our options for 2017 and communicate those to the association in a timely manner.

Fishery Report

Lake Sarah Experiences late June Fish Kill

The Department of Natural Resources came out to Lake Sarah the week of June 20th after multiple residents reported significant amount of fish (mostly crappies) on their shorelines. The DNR reported having seen similar kills on 8 other area lakes. They brought sample fish to the University of Minnesota Diagnostic Lab and the results look consistent with dispersed and rapid warm water temperature increases where bacteria and fungus stress the fish. It is definitely sad news that the lake lost the fish, but the good news is that nothing more serious occurred.
